(Athletes 14 – 21 years)

(Athletes 16 – 21 years)

**Entries**: As per schedule.

Teams: A national team shall consist of at least one Child, one Junior and one

Young Driver and each Nation is entitled to send up to a maximum of 6 Athletes, maximum 2 per age category. NFs which cannot send a team may send up to 4 Athletes in total as individual entries, maximum 2 per

age category.

The team classification will be determined by adding together the scores from the Athlete in each class with the lowest penalties in each Competition. Only those scores of the team Members who have completed all three Competitions without Elimination can be counted towards the

final team scores.

Individuals: All entered Athletes will compete as Individuals in their respective

classes.
