

Conditions participation at the CAI2*/3* Kronenberg 13-16 May 2021

The Organising Committee of the CAI Kronenberg is very happy to announce, that the international event which is planned from 13th to 16th May, can take place! To meet all requirements to prevent the spreading of the Covid-19 and the EHV-virus, the OC has received the following conditions imposed by the Dutch Government.

More details regarding these conditions will follow after the definite entry date:

Covid-19:

- 1. All competitors and their team members must take a quick Covid-test upon arrival in Kronenberg. The whole team must arrive at the same time.
- 2. Maximum number of persons allowed per competitor:

Single horse/pony: 1 competitor and 2 persons Pair horse/pony: 1 competitor and 3 persons Team horse/pony: 1 competitor and 4 persons

3. Arrival is **only possible on Thursday 13 May** because of the availability of the quick Covid-test location. Competitors are required to arrive in the following time slots:

H4/P4: 08.00 – 11.00 hrs. H2/P2: 11.00 – 14.00 hrs. H1/P1/PE: 14.00 – 16.00 hrs.

- 4. It is NOT possible for team members and competitors to arrive after 13 May.
- 5. Maximum 1 trainer and 1 chef d'equipe per National Federation. These persons must also be tested on Thursday 13 May.
- 6. The costs for the quick Covid-test are €50 per test and need to be paid beforehand. Results from other Covid-tests are not accepted.
- 7. The result will be available after 15 mins. When all team members are tested negative, the competitor will be directed to the camp site. If one or more team members are tested positive, the whole team will be excluded from the competition and will be required to leave the competition site immediately.
- 8. It is not allowed for teams to have physical contact/visit each other. When this does happen, the competitors responsible will be required to leave the competition site.
- 9. Wearing a nose/face mask is always obligatory on the complete competition site except for the competitors camp site, whilst on the carriage and for those who trot the horse up during the horse inspection.
- 10. Every competitor will receive a parking space of 10 x 20 m2. Everybody will need to keep 0,75 cm distance from the sidelines so we can keep 1,5 meter distance at all times between competitors camps because of the Covid-19 regulations.
- 11. Get-togethers during course walks is not allowed. We need to prevent that photos of groups are taken which may cause cancellation of our event.

- 12. Leaving procedure: please follow the rules and regulations of the country you are travelling to. We are currently looking into the possibility to organise a quick Covidtest location on Sunday 16 May. More information will follow later.
- 13. The definite entry date has changed to Thursday 29 April 2021.
- 14. Cancellations of entries made before or on 29 April 2021: no penalty.

 Cancellations of entries made between 3 May -10 May 2021: 50% of the fee for the amount of boxes reserved, the entry fee and the accommodation fee will be charged to the National Federation.

Cancellations of entries made from 11 May 2021: 100% of the fee for the amount of boxes reserved, the entry fee and the accommodation fee will be charged to the National Federation.

EHV

- The OC will not allow more than 400 horses to compete, the PCR-test for horses is therefore not necessary.
